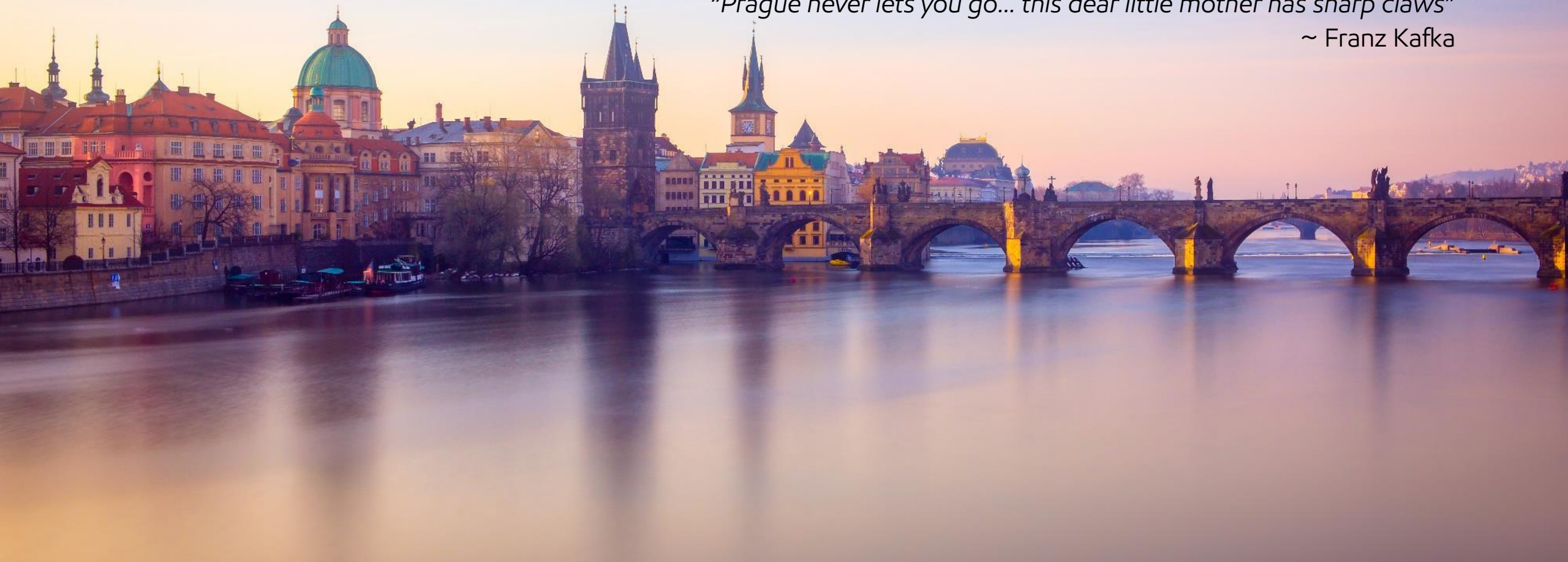

# Salaries in Czech Republic



## Salary is paid monthly and retrospectively

This means that you will get your first salary after one month working. Usually the salary is paid between the 10th and 18th day of **the month**.

## Gross Salary for junior positions

The average salary for Junior Positions is between 33.000 and 38.000 CZK.

## Net Salary for junior positions

Between 25.000 and 29.000 CZK (approx. €980 and €1.140).  
With the exchange rate:  
1 EUR = 25,5 CZK.

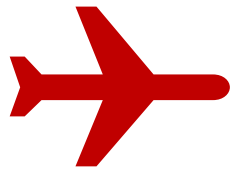
# Public Transportation

- Public transport in Prague is extensive, integrated, cheap, fast, safe and reliable.
- **Subway/metro, buses** or **trams** operate anytime during the day, some at night.
- Tickets are sold at any newspaper stand or in subway stations. Tickets must be validated on entry otherwise they are invalid.
- With the [Litacka](#) card you can travel one month for 550 CZK (20 €) or buy the yearly ticket for 3.650 CZK (145 €).
- At [www.dpp.cz/en](http://www.dpp.cz/en) you can find all you need to know about tickets, schedules and prices.
- For travelling outside of Prague, use the large network of [train](#) or [bus](#) transportation.

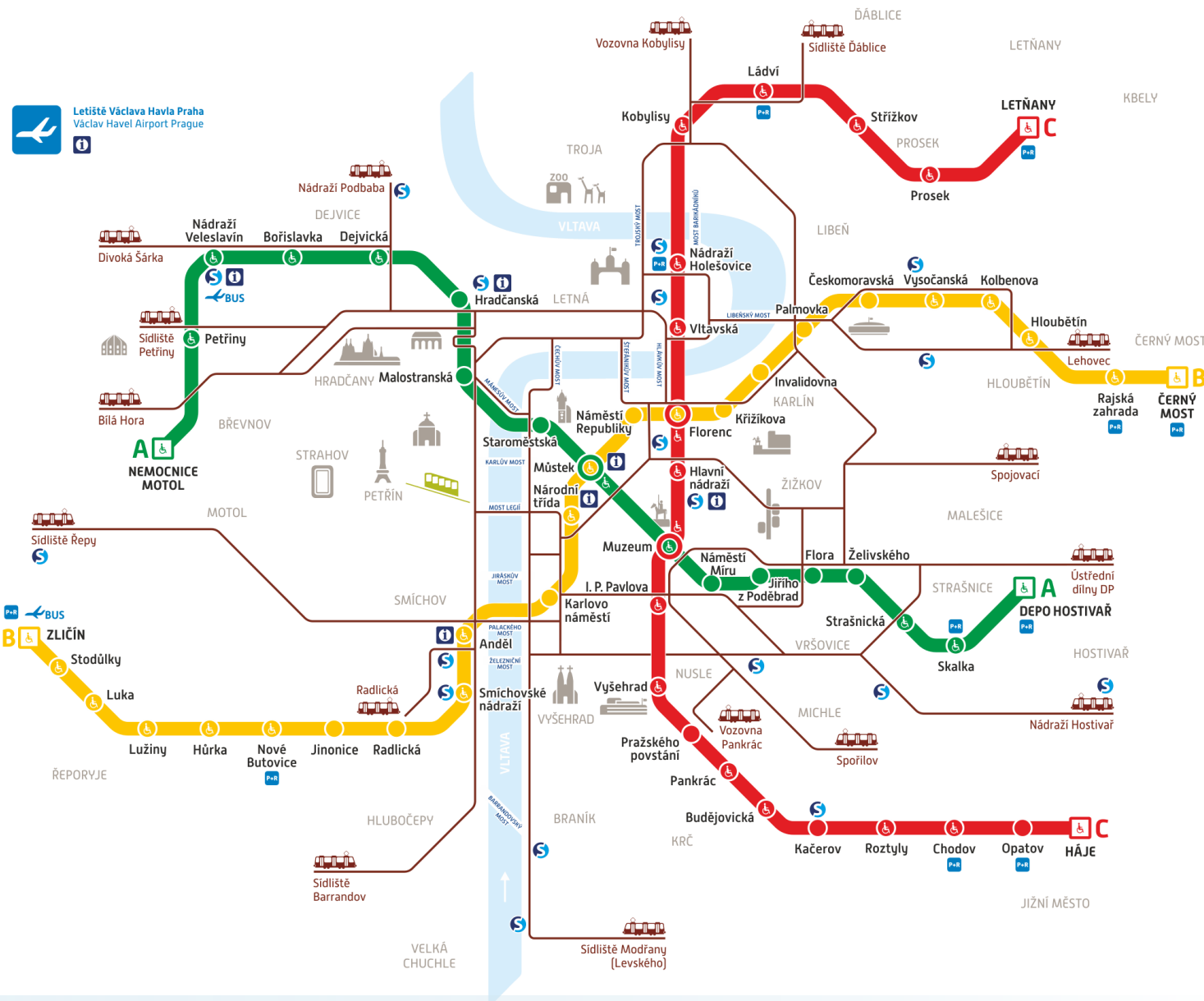

# Cost Of Living In Prague - Facts



Cost of living rank **256th** out of 439 cities in the world (first on being most expensive)

Average Monthly **Net Salary** In Prague (after tax)  
**27,846.22 CZK**

Prague has a cost of living index of  
**48.64**

A **single person** monthly costs  
**10,857.04 CZK** without rent.

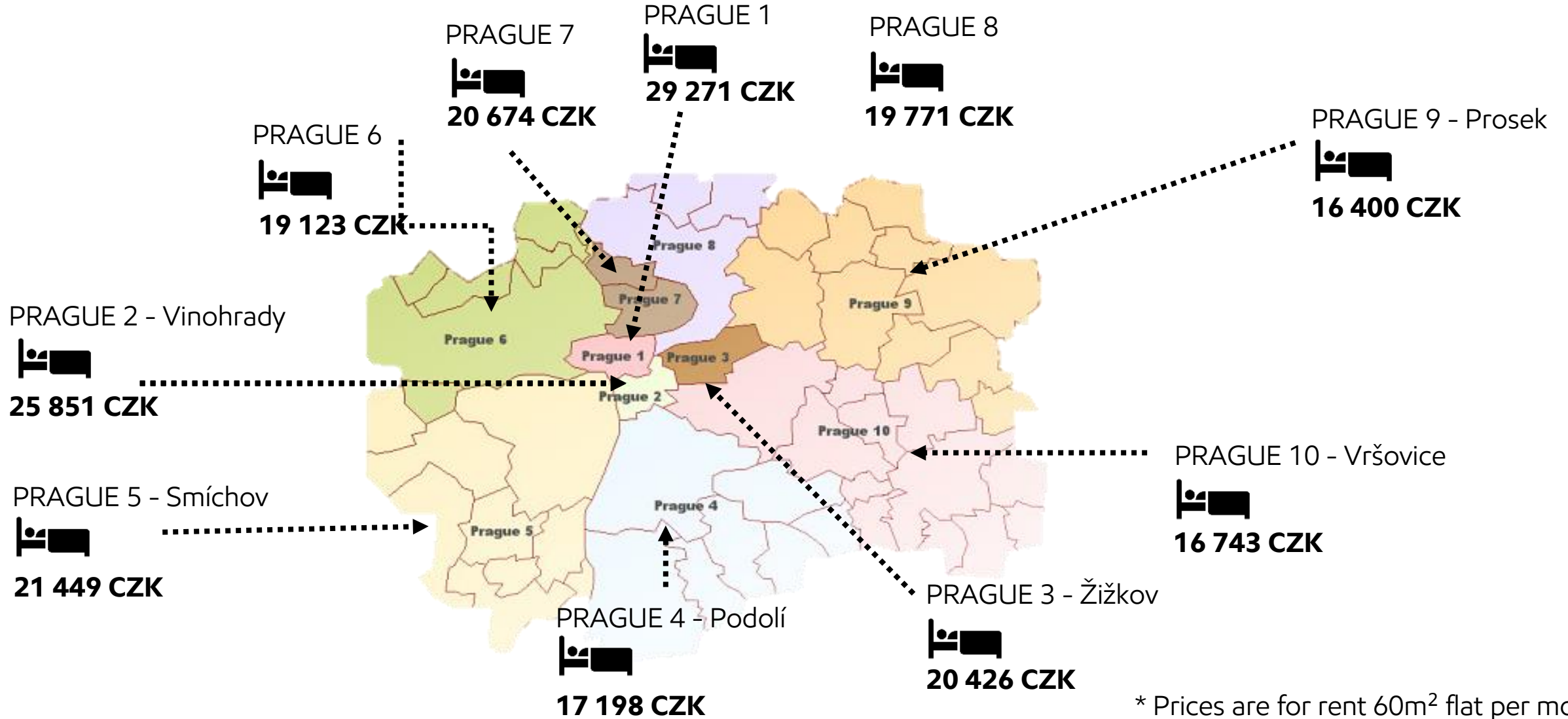

# Health and Social Insurance

Health and Social insurance will be deducted automatically from your salary (gross amount) and together with other taxes, influences the net value we mentioned before.

I N S U R A N C E

Health insurance is obligatory for everybody and provides full medical care.

# Banks and bank accounts

- You will need to set up a Bank Account to receive your first salary.
- It is really easy and fast to open an account in the Czech Republic.

**Many banks offer the account free of charge. All you need is:**

- ID or Passport
- Address
- Phone Number

# Currency Exchange

**Cash Machines** - some banks charge international fees

**Banks** - always charge a commission based on the exchanged amount

**Exchange Offices** - check the rates and commission

**Our tip:** *Even though euros are now accepted in Prague at almost all shops, supermarkets and restaurants, the exchange rates fluctuate and are not accurate to actual rates. We recommend to change your money first. At most places you can pay by credit or debit card (MasterCard, Visa, Maestro).*
